Purpose of Report

The Members of the Licensing (2003 Act) Sub-Committee are asked to hear and determine an application for a new premises licence for;

An application for a new premises licence was received by the Licensing Authority on 16 April 2012. This was advertised at the premises and in the local newspaper; a copy of the application is attached as **Appendix A**. The application is for;

Supply of alcohol (on premises only)

- 07:30 hours to 23:00 hours every day

Representations

- The Metropolitan Police pro active licensing team has made representations on the licensing objective of Prevention of Crime and Disorder. A copy of their letter is attached as **Appendix B**.

Comments of the Legal Officer

Where the Licensing Authority decides to impose conditions on a licence (whether in a Cumulative Impact Zone or not), such conditions must be appropriate and proportionate for the promotion of the Licensing Objectives. Conditions should be clear and unequivocal.

The Secretary of State has issued guidance to Licensing Authorities to which they

must have regard in carrying out their licensing functions. Members of the Sub-Committee should note that copies of the guidance are available at meetings of the Sub-Committee. Alternatively, copies can be obtained direct from the Committee Clerk. Licensing Authorities may only depart from the guidance if they have good reasons to do so.
